Upon our arrival Benis was able to get a container out of customs with school furniture that was donated from a New York school. We hosted several teams who have helped us minister to hundreds of Haitians.



The second week was very busy because the medical team treated hundreds, the dental team treated and extracted close to eight hundred teeth!

We have started having Bible study three times a week and Sunday afternoon a study about what it means to be a Christian and about baptism. Dominique started children's church on Sunday. The first Sunday we had eighty children and they too are learning about Jesus!

We were happy when the container finally arrived with the church doors, school books, supplies, and some of our personal items! It was a lot of work to get it to our location, but the Lord enabled us to do it!



Easter eve Benis, team members, and many saints from the church made the trek down the mountainside to the Atlantic Ocean. What a beautiful sight when six individuals were baptized on that morning.



Kite Day was a huge success! Thirty kites were donated from our friends. The boys had a blasted.


