The Association de l'Ouest et du Sud-est de la CMBH an extension of the Southern Baptist in Haiti held a seminar for the Baptist churches in the 8th zone from May 1st 4th. Ninety-eight attendees came from different church plants under Pastor Benis' leadership in La Gonave. Topics taught were biblical administrative principles, characteristics of Christian servants, truth about spiritual gifts, and many others.



Institution Guerrier premiered its Art Show. Mapou Village showed off its future artists. All the classes exhibited their extraordinary art work. Parents were invited to enjoy all the works of art. They were also encouraged to vote and judge on the art work displayed.



May 18th is Flag Day in Haiti. The students from the Guerrier Institute celebrated with the children marching in the village. During Chapel, Mr. Alner, the 5th grade teacher, gave the children a history lesson of how the Haitian flag came about. We even learned all the interesting facts of how the Haitian national anthem was created.



A medical team treated 150 patients in a day. They treated newborns and even performed acupuncture on some patients.



During Student Sunday, the third Sunday in May, the children led the service with songs and verses from the Bible. Dominique gave special recognition to all the students for their beautiful art work. Awards were given to a child from each class who demonstrated artistic excellence. Mr. Adam, the fourth grade teacher received a certificate as well for having a passion to teach art in his class.
