The Lord is working in the lives of the people of Mapou village and throughout Haiti. Missionary teams, my family and I have traveled to the Island of La Gonave, Haiti a total of 5 times during the year of 2007. We laid the foundation of the Church/School/

Clinic, and now we just finished of posting the blocks of the building. The third phase is stop because of lack of water. We are going in March to pour concrete inside of the building. If God provides with some rain, we will be able to have some cistern water.
